

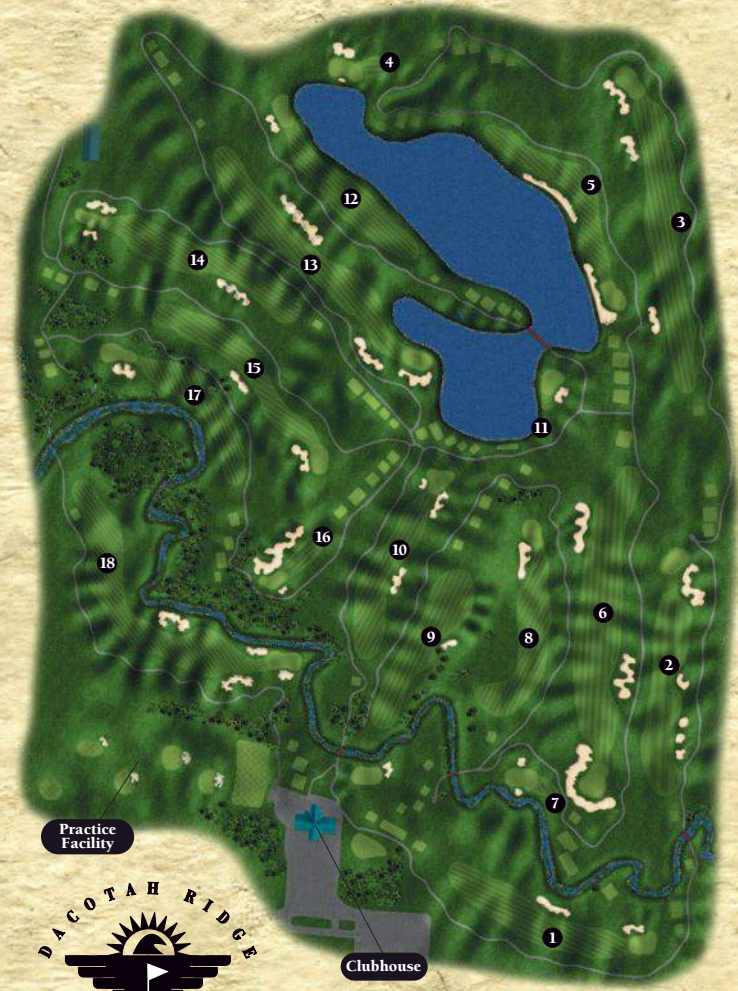

EXCEPT WHERE MODIFIED BY LOCAL RULES**

- Red stakes define lateral water hazards.
- Yellow stakes define water hazards.
- Split-rail fence on holes 16, 17 and 18 are in play. Proceed under Rule 24-2 for interference and relief.
- Exterior fence that surrounds golf course defines out-of-bounds.
- Color at top of 150-yard pole indicates hole position. Red — Front, White — Middle, Blue — Back.
- All yardages measured to the middle of the green.
